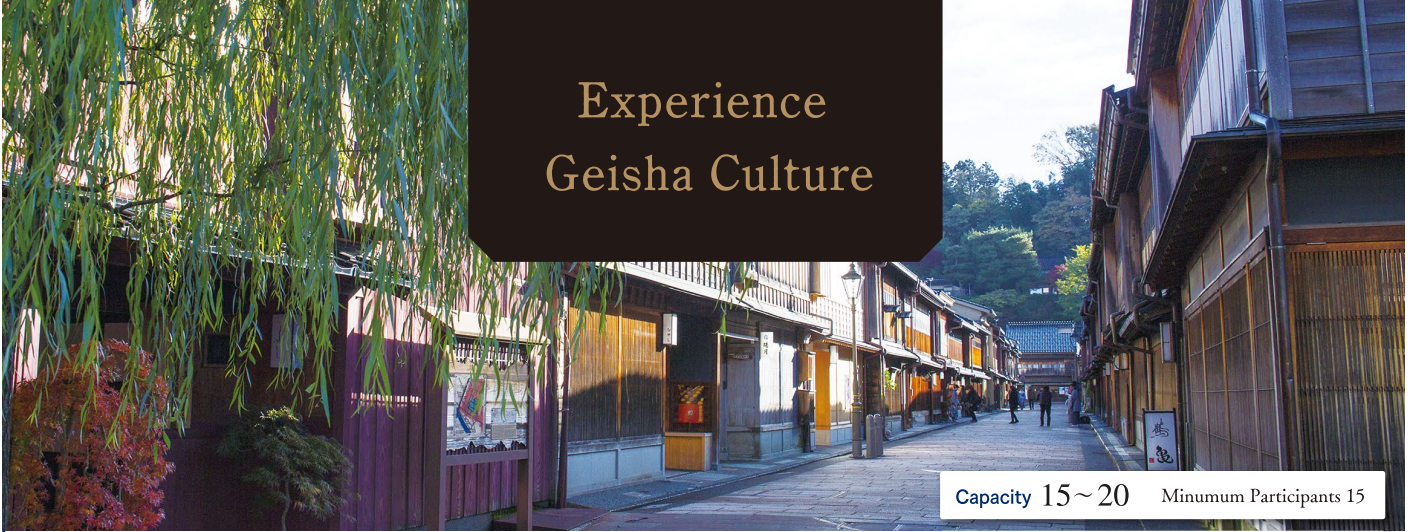

Kanazawa Geiko Ozashiki Party Experience

In Kanazawa, there are three chaya districts, Higashi, Nishi and Kazue-machi, which have been around since the Edo period, and about 35 geiko have inherited the traditional art and hospitality of chaya culture. Enjoy the graceful dances and the music by Kanazawa geiko who devote themselves to it every day, and play a Ozashiki party game. You can also enjoy talking with geiko and taking commemorative photos.



Kanazawa Asanogawa Enyukai Hall

It opened in 2022 near Higashi Chaya District as the base for sharing information that conveys the history and the culture of chaya (geisha house) district and the charm of the Asanogawa River area. With actual displays of drums, flutes, shamisen guitars, and hand fans, you can feel the chic and elegant geiko culture of chaya district closely. The quaint architectural beauty of the 100-year-old Kanazawa townhouse is also a highlight.
